# **GET RICH: GOD'S GRACE**

LESSON #3

**TEACHER'S GUIDE** 

#### **LESSON OVERVIEW**

**Big Idea:** We can't brag about God's grace. **Key Question:** Why can't we brag about grace?

Memory Verse: "Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it." Ephesians 2:9

Overview: We're continuing in our series called "Get Rich". We're not talking about getting rich with money. We're talking about being rich in God's love. We're looking at the book of Ephesians and some important lessons Paul teaches about the benefits of having a relationship with God. We've already learned that when we put our trust in Jesus, we are adopted into God's family. We become a child of God and get all the benefits of being in God's family; protection, blessings, and heaven. We've also learned that we should get to know God more so we can understand how great he is. Today, we're going to talk about the riches that come from God's grace. The word grace means gift. God's gift of grace means he is kind and forgiving towards us. Now, notice the important word gift. God gives us grace, not because we've earned it by doing good things or looking really good. It's a gift he simply offers us because he loves us. All we can do is receive the gift. We do that by putting our trust in Jesus. That's it! It's simple. That's why we shouldn't ever boast about our relationship with God. We can't earn God's love and forgiveness. It's all about Jesus and what he chose to do for us.

#### **TEACHER TIPS**

Don't forget that you set the tone for your kids. Smile. Have fun. Pursue God together.

We work hard to be good at something. We put a lot of time and energy into it. But we can't earn God's love and forgiveness. His love and forgiveness are gifts he gives us and it's not something we can work really hard to earn.

### Answer: Grace is a gift God offers to us free of charge.

When you give someone a gift, you do it because you love them and want to show them how much you care about them. You don't make them do a lot of stuff for you before you give them a gift. If that were the case, your gift would be more like a payment. This is how God's grace works. His grace (kind and forgiving) is a gift he gives us because he loves us. We don't have to do stuff to earn it. It's simply a gift God offers us. All we can do is accept the gift by trusting in Jesus.

**Bonus Questions:** What does grace mean? (gift of kindness and forgiveness) How do we accept the gift? **4-5th:** Why does it matter that God's grace is a gift and not

something we can earn? (Our focus is on God and how great he is, not on ourselves or the great things we think we've done).

God is **compassionate** (cares about us and hates to see us sad) and full of **mercy** (chooses forgiveness over punishment). He's slow to be **angry** and full of **love** and **faithfulness** (he'll never let us down).

## Option #1

# Option #2

#### Don't Brag, Be Thankful Hand Craft

- Give each kid a piece of construction paper.
- Have kids trace their handprint onto the paper. Make sure their fingers are spread out so it's easier to cut.
- Then have kids cut out their handprint.
- Give each kid a handprint template (page 6).
- Have kids cut out each saying. Have them glue "I thank God for..." onto the palm and the others onto the fingers.
- As they work, explain why it's important to thank God for each of those things.
  - "Creating Me"-God made each one of us with special talents and abilities.
  - "Grace"-God's grace is a gift of kindness and forgiveness.
  - "Forgiveness"-Jesus died to pay for our sins.  $\circ$
  - "Loving Me"-God loves us so much that he sent Jesus to die for our sins.
  - "The Cross"- Where Jesus died to fix our sin problem.

## Supplies needed

- Construction paper, ½ sheet per kid
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Handprint template (pg 6), 1 set per kid
- Glue

Think about the best gift you ever gave to someone. Maybe you gave your best friend great big piece of candy. Or maybe you gave your parents a special art project you worked on all year long at school. I'm sure those gifts were pretty special. But they're not even close to the gift that Jesus gave us when he died on the cross for us! Because of his gift, we can be saved.
