TEACHER'S GUIDE

LESSON OVERVIEW

Big Idea: A Christian grid helps you know how to loveKey Question: How does God want us to love others?Memory Verse: So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other John 13:34

Overview: We're continuing our series called the Grid. Grid is just a fancy word for how you look at life. We've already learned that a Christian Grid means we see life like Jesus does. Last week, we learned how important the Bible is to a Christian grid. The Bible is God's truth. We should run every idea through the Bible "sifter". Then we'll know if that idea is good or bad. Today, we're going to talk about another important part of a Christian Grid. It's all about love. The Bible says that God is love so he knows how to love better than anyone. It's just who he is. So, if we see life like God does, then we should be good at love, too. First, we should love God. We do that by reading the Bible and obeying what it says. Second, we should love others. We should put other people ahead of ourselves and treat them the way we would want to be treated. Love is important to a Christian Grid so make sure you're loving God and loving others!

Classroom Activities **K-1st**

Option #1

Heart Map Craft

- Give each kid a heart template (page 5).
- Tell the kids that they're going to make a heart map that shows what they care about. So, with a Christian Grid in mind, in the middle of the heart are the two most important commandments: Love God and Love others. But, around the heart are different sections that represent other people and things that they love.
- Have kids draw something in each section that represents something else they love. (pet, friends, siblings, parents, teacher, hobby or sport,)

Supplies needed

- Heart Template (pg. 5), pre cut, 1 per kid
- Pencils
- Crayons/Markers

Bonus Activity: Play Bible Hangman.

Words or phrases: Love God, Love others, Christian

Option #2

Love Scramble Game

- As a class, work together to unscramble the message. (hint: you will have 2 phrases and the memory verse)
- Put the scramble template (**page 6**) hearts face down on a table and allow each kid to come pick one and tape it to the whiteboard. Keep doing this until all the hearts are taped to the board.
- As you add hearts, have kids help you to move the hearts in the right order to unscramble the message. (answers: 1. Love God 2. Love Others, memory verse.)

Supplies needed

- Whiteboard
- Tape
- Scramble template (pg. 6), pre cut, 1 set per class

Bonus Activity: Play Find the Book in the Bible.

Have the class get into pairs. Give each pair a Bible. Have them race to find the books below. First to find has to say if it's in the OT or NT

Every time you obey your parents, you show that you love God. It's good practice for when you move out someday. You'll be good at obeying God because you've been good at obeying your parents.

Jesus said to love _____ second

See, when you learn how to love God with all your heart, you'll automatically start loving other people better. Do you know why? Because God will turn you into a more loving person! God is love, and that love will rub off on you.

- 2. Why do we need to love God first? How does our relationship with God help us to love others?
- 3. How has God shown you love? How do you show love to God?
- 4. How do you show love to your parents? Your friends? Your siblings?

Answers: love, God, others


Bonus Questions:

- 3. Read 1 John 4:7. Where does love come from? How can you share God's love with others?


