## LESSON OVERVIEW

**Big Idea:** Happiness starts with knowing you need God. **Key Question:** Why do we need God? **Memory Verse:** God makes you happy when you realize your need for Him. Matthew 5:3

**Overview:** Did you know that Jesus was a great teacher! When He spoke, people listened. We're going to be learning about the most famous class He ever taught. It's called the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus stood on top of a mountain and taught the people some really important things. One of His main points was about real happiness. That would be interesting, right? We all want to be happy. But, Jesus wasn't talking about the kind of happy you feel when you eat a yummy lunch at Chick fil A or even that feeling when you're opening presents on Christmas or on your birthday. He was talking about a lasting happiness that can only come from God. It starts with realizing you can't do anything without God. In fact, Jesus tells us that we need to come to Him like a child. You know what that means? We're all like helpless kids when we come to God. That's true even for adults. Just like kids need their parents, we need God to take care of us. And when we have the attitude that says "God knows what's best for me" we'll experience real happiness.

# **TEACHER TIPS**

2nd-5th puzzle answers: across: 1. happy 2. Jesus down: 1 humble

Allow each kid to share. The point: there are lots of things that make us happy. But, usually it never lasts. We're always looking for the next thing.

Answer: We need God for two main things.

- 1. **Forgive our sins.** We need Him to fix our sin problem. Remember, we can't have a relationship with God, or go to Heaven, if we don't trust Jesus for the forgiveness of our sin. Only God can fix that..
- 2. We need Him for **everything else**, too. God created each and every one of us. He knows what we need even better than we do. He wants to take care of us, in the big things and small things.

### **Bonus Questions:**

**K-st:** What do your parents provide for you? Could you do any of those things on your own?

**2nd-5th:** Give your own definition of sin. (going our own way instead of God's) What did Jesus do for us? (died on the cross to forgive sin) What things do you ask God to help you with?

One of the most important qualities God wants us to have is humility. We need to be humble. Simply put: don't think more of yourself than you should. We don't come to God with anything to offer. We're like helpless little babies. God did it all when He sent Jesus to die for us. We just simply accept the gift. We can't do it alone. We need help.

# Option #1

## Happy Hot Potato

A great game to test what kids have learned. Have kids stand in a circle. Give one kid the ball. If you have some music, play it while the kids just toss it around to other kids in the circle. Stop the music, or just say "stop", periodically. Whoever is holding the "potato" has to answer a question. If they get it right, they get to stay in the game. If wrong, they have to sit down.

# Option #2

### Sermon Says

This game works like "Simon Says" but with a Bible twist. Give a simple task for the kids to do. If a child fails, give them a question to answer from below to stay in the game. If they get it right, they continue to play. If they get it wrong, they sit down.

Actions: jump up and down, hop on one leg, wave right arm, spin around, whistle, two thumbs up, etc.




